**PRO:** Since 2003, Ken Amato has served as a long snapper for both field goals and punts and contributed as a valued core member of special teams coverage units. His steady snaps have made an impact in Rob Bironas' emergence as a Pro Bowl kicker and have helped Brett Kern emerge as one of the NFL's top young punters. Prior to Crag Hentrich's retirement in 2010, Amato's consistency helped Hentrich ascend to the top of the team's all-time leader board in career punting. Amato also has experience in extra-linebacker defensive packages.

### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- In his first eight NFL seasons (2003-10), he played in 109 games and totaled 46 special teams tackles, including six stops on special teams in 2010. As a situational linebacker, he has seven career tackles.
- He has served as the long snapper for a 60-yard, game-winning field goal (12/4/06 vs. Indianapolis) and an NFL-record eight field goals in a game (10/21/07 at Houston), both by Rob Bironas.

### TITANS TIDBITS:

- Amato played in his first NFL game nearly five years after playing his final college game. After his college eligibility expired at the end of the 1998 season, he spent the next two years finishing his degree and assisting Montana State's coaching staff with video work and a wide variety of other tasks. After graduation, with the exception of a brief stint with the Carolina Panthers in May 2002, he worked two years as a full-time juvenile service specialist in Miami until re-signing to attend his second camp with Carolina in February 2003.
- While Amato's father, Paul, is Italian-Irish, his mother, Isora Gotay, is from Puerto Rico. As a result, he speaks fluent Spanish and still communicates with his mother's side of the family in her native tongue.
- Amato learned to long snap in his last year playing Pop Warner football, but he did not do it again until college. During his time at Moorpark (Calif.) Junior College, he suffered an injury to his MCL and was unable to play linebacker for a short period. Because the team needed a long snapper, he volunteered for the duty because he wanted to stay involved while allowing his injury to heal.

### CAREER TRANSACTIONS:

- The Miami, Fla., native was originally signed by the Carolina Panthers as an undrafted free agent on May 28, 2002 but was waived during his first training camp.
- Served a second stint with the Panthers from Feb. 11 to June 11, 2003.
- Signed by the Titans as a free agent on Aug. 12, 2003.

### SEASON RECAPS:

- 2011 (16/0):** Played in all 16 games as the team's long snapper and posted three special teams tackles. Tied for the team lead in special teams tackles once in 2011 (at ATL).
- At Jacksonville (9/11), saw action as the long snapper and made a special teams tackle.
  - Against Baltimore (9/18), played as a reserve as the long snapper.
  - Against Denver (9/25), saw action as a reserve long snapper. Had an errant snap that Brett Kern scooped up and raced 21 yards down the right sideline.
  - At Cleveland (10/2), saw time as the team's long snapper.
  - At Pittsburgh (10/9), played as a reserve long snapper.
  - Against Houston (10/23), saw action as the long snapper.
  - Against Indianapolis (10/30), played in a reserve role as the long snapper and collected a special teams stop.
  - Against Cincinnati (11/6), saw action as the long snapper.

- At Carolina (11/13), played as a reserve at long snapper.
- At Atlanta (11/20), saw action at long snapper and tied for the team lead with a special teams stop.
- Against Tampa Bay (11/27), played as a reserve as the long snapper.
- At Buffalo (12/4), served as the team's long snapper.
- Against New Orleans (12/11), saw action as the team's long snapper.
- At Indianapolis (12/18), played as a reserve as the long snapper.
- Against Jacksonville (12/24), saw action as a reserve at long snapper.
- At Houston (1/1), played as a reserve as the team's long snapper.

- 2010 (16/0):** Served as the long snapper in all 16 games for the fifth time in his career and for the third consecutive season. He collected six special teams tackles. His snaps helped Rob Bironas tie the franchise record for single-season field goal percentage (92.3) and helped Brett Kern finish with the third-highest net punting average (39.06) in team annals.
- He notched one special teams stop in games against Pittsburgh (9/19), at N.Y. Giants (9/26), against Denver (10/3), at Jacksonville (10/18), at San Diego (10/31) and at Kansas City (12/26).
  - At Indianapolis (1/2), saw action as the long snapper but left the game on the last play of the second quarter with an injury.

- 2009 (16/0):** Played all 16 games for the fourth time in his career and for the second consecutive season. Registered five solo special teams tackles on coverage units.
- Posted one special teams tackle in games at Jacksonville (10/4), against Arizona (11/29) and against St. Louis (12/13) and additionally tied for the team lead with two special teams stops at New England (10/18).
  - Against Indianapolis (10/11), gave the Titans excellent field position by pouncing on a Tim Jennings muffed punt on the Colts' 37-yard line in the first quarter.

- 2008 (16/0, 1/0):** Served as long snapper in all 16 games and contributed to Rob Bironas' 87.9 field goal percentage (tied for 10th in NFL). Registered four special teams tackles.
- Collected a special teams tackle in games against Houston (9/21), at Baltimore (10/5), against Cleveland (12/7) and at Indianapolis (12/28).

- 2007 (7/0, 0/0):** Played in seven games and totaled three special teams tackles before being placed on injured reserve on Oct. 31, 2007 with a knee injury.
- At Houston (10/21), served as long snapper for Rob Bironas' single-game NFL record eight field goals.
  - Against Oakland (10/28), tore his right ACL and spent the remainder of season on injured reserve.

- 2006 (15/0):** Played in 15 games and totaled five special teams tackles and three tackles at linebacker, including one tackle for loss. Helped kicker Rob Bironas go 22 of 28 on field goal attempts and 32 of 32 on PAT attempts. Snapped for three of the team's four game-winning field goals (11/26 vs. N.Y. Giants, 12/3 vs. Indianapolis and 12/24 at Buffalo). He was inactive in one game (10/15 at Washington) with a quad injury.
- Following week against Indianapolis (12/3), snapped for Bironas' game-winning 60-yard field goal, the sixth field goal in NFL history from 60 yards or longer.

- 2005 (7/0):** Played in seven games as a long snapper until breaking his left fibula at Arizona (10/23). He was placed on injured reserve on Oct. 26.

- 2004 (16/0):** Served as team's long snapper and contributed 10 special

teams tackles. Also received occasional playing time in a four-linebacker package, where he posted four stops.

- In Monday Night Football victory at Green Bay (10/11), recorded season-high two tackles in first career action at linebacker.

**2003 (16/0, 2/0):** In his first season, played in every regular season game and both postseason games. Served as punting unit's long snapper and contributed nine special teams tackles during regular season.

- Against Oakland (9/7), played on special teams in professional debut.

**COLLEGE:**

- Played in 22 games with nine starts in two seasons at Montana State.
- In addition to action at long snapper, collected 41 tackles, three sacks and one fumble recovery at linebacker as senior in 1998.
- Contributed 48 tackles and 2.5 sacks at defensive end and linebacker as a junior (1997).
- Prior to attending Montana State, spent two seasons at Moorpark (Calif.) Junior College, earning all-state and all-conference honors as sophomore.
- Earned degree in justice studies.

- Married to Sandi (July 2004), couple resides in Brentwood, Tenn., with daughter, Jazlyn.
- Named to Dade County All-Star team at Braddock High School in Miami, Fla., where he also played volleyball and participated in the high jump in track and field.

- Participated in youth football clinic in Puerto Rico in 2006.
