**PRO:** The Titans used their fifth-round pick in the 2014 NFL Draft on Kentucky linebacker Avery Williamson. The 6-foot-1-inch, 246-pound defender entered the NFL with a reputation as an aggressive, downhill, sure-tackling inside linebacker. In 2016, Williamson led the team with 149 tackles and became the first player in the Titans era to start his career with back-to-back-to-back 100-tackle seasons. He had one of the most productive seasons of any Titans defensive rookie in recent memory in 2014. Even though he did not record his first start until Week 5, he produced 107 tackles to rank third on the team and record the highest tackle total by a rookie in the "Titans era" (1999–present).

### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- In 2016, Williamson led the team in tackles for the second consecutive season with 149 stops.
- In 2015, Williamson led the team with 137 tackles and ranked third on the squad with nine tackles for loss. He became the first player in the Titans era to start his career with back-to-back 100-tackle seasons.
- As a rookie, Williamson saw action in all 16 games with 12 starts at linebacker and ranked third on the team with 107 tackles. He also tied for third on the squad with three sacks.
- As a senior at Kentucky, Williamson was a team captain and led the squad in tackles for the second consecutive season. His 102 tackles tied for fourth place in the SEC.

### TITANS TIDBITS:

- Williamson grew up in the West Tennessee town of Milan, which is approximately a two-hour drive from Nashville. He lists Eddie George, Steve McNair and Jevon Kearse as his favorite Titans as a child.
- During the 2016 offseason, Williamson spent time as an analyst on the set of NFL Network.
- One of Williamson's "bucket list" items is to see the pyramids in Egypt.
- In 2013, he was chosen to represent the Kentucky football program on a one-week educational/service trip in Ethiopia.

### CAREER TRANSACTIONS:

- The Milan, Tenn., native was selected by the Titans in the fifth round (151st overall) of the 2014 NFL Draft.

### SEASON RECAPS:

**2017 (16/16, 2/2):** Started all 16 games at linebacker and ranked second on the team with 125 tackles, three sacks, 12 quarterback pressures, seven stops for loss, two passes defended and two forced fumbles. Started at linebacker in his first two career postseason games and amassed two tackles, a quarterback pressure and a pass defended. Led or tied for the team lead in tackles five times in 2017 (vs. OAK, at MIA, at CLE, at IND, vs. JAX). Tied for the team lead in sacks once in 2017 (at SF). Led the team in quarterback pressures once in 2017 (at SF). Tied for the team lead in passes defended once in 2017 (at JAX).

- Against Oakland (9/10), started at linebacker and tied for the team lead with 10 tackles. Stopped DeAndre Washington for no gain on a rush off right tackle in the final stanza.
- At Jacksonville (9/17), started at linebacker and collected nine tackles and a pass defended. Tipped a pass intended for Marqise Lee that was then intercepted by Curtis Riley in the second quarter.
- Against Seattle (9/24), started at linebacker and notched eight tackles.
- At Houston (10/1), started at linebacker and tallied eight tackles and a quarterback pressure.
- At Miami (10/8), started at linebacker and led the team with 10 tackles. Combined with Erik Walden to stuff Jay Ajayi for no gain on a rush off right

guard in the third quarter.

- Against Indianapolis (10/16), started at linebacker and recorded six tackles and a forced fumble. Forced a Jack Doyle fumble that was recovered by Wesley Woodyard in the third quarter.
- At Cleveland (10/22), started at linebacker and led the team with 15 tackles, including a stop for loss. Stuffed Isaiah Crowell for a five-yard loss on a rush off right tackle in the third quarter.
- Against Baltimore (11/5), started at linebacker and collected seven tackles and a quarterback pressure.
- Against Cincinnati (11/12), started at linebacker and recorded a tackle.
- At Pittsburgh (11/16), started at linebacker and notched four tackles.
- At Indianapolis (11/26), started at linebacker and led the team with 12 tackles, including a sack, a stop for loss and a quarterback pressure. Teamed with Kevin Dodd to stuff Frank Gore for no gain on a rush up the middle in the second quarter. Combined with Wesley Woodyard to stonewall Gore for a one-yard loss on a rush off right guard in the third quarter. Sacked Jacoby Brissett in the third quarter.
- Against Houston (12/3), started at linebacker and produced seven tackles and a quarterback pressure. Combined with DaQuan Jones to stuff Lamar Miller for no gain on a rush off left guard in the first quarter. Teamed with Johnathan Cyprien to stop Alfred Blue for a one-yard loss on a rush up the middle in the first quarter.
- At Arizona (12/10), started at linebacker and tallied four tackles, including a sack, a stop for loss and a quarterback pressure. Sacked Blaine Gabbert for a four-yard loss on third-and-eight late in the fourth quarter.
- At San Francisco (12/17), started at linebacker and posted six tackles, including a sack, a team-best four quarterback pressures and two stops for loss. Flew through the line and sacked Jimmy Garoppolo for an eight-yard loss in the first quarter. Stuffed Carlos Hyde for a four-yard loss on a rush off left tackle in the second stanza.
- Against Los Angeles Rams (12/24), started at linebacker and notched six tackles and two quarterback pressures.
- Against Jacksonville (12/31), started at linebacker and led the team with 12 tackles, including two stops for loss, a quarterback pressure, a forced fumble and a pass defended. Batted down a pass intended for James O'Shaughnessy early in the first quarter. Stuffed T.J. Yeldon for a two-yard loss on a screen pass in the opening stanza. Stonewalled Leonard Fournette for no gain on a rush off right tackle in the first quarter. Combined with Sylvester Williams to stop Fournette for no gain on a rush off left guard in the third stanza. Forced a Fournette fumble that was recovered by the Jaguars in the fourth quarter.
- At Kansas City (1/6), started at linebacker and recorded a tackle and a quarterback pressure in his first career postseason game. Combined with Wesley Woodyard to stuff Kareem Hunt for a one-yard loss on a rush off right end in the third quarter.
- At New England (1/13), started at linebacker and registered a tackle and a pass defended. Teamed with Kevin Byard to stop James White for no gain on a rush up the middle early in the second quarter. Broke up a pass intended for Rob Gronkowski on the first play of the fourth quarter.

**2016 (16/16):** Started all 16 games at linebacker and led the team for the second consecutive season with 149 tackles. Led or tied for the team lead in tackles 13 times in 2016 (vs. MIN, at DET, vs. OAK, at HOU, at MIA, vs. CLE, vs. IND, vs. JAX, at SD, at IND, at CHI, vs. DEN, vs. HOU). Tied for the team lead in sacks twice in 2016 (vs. CLE, vs. JAX).

- Against Minnesota (9/11), started at linebacker and led the team with 10 tackles, including a stop for loss and a quarterback pressure. Teamed with Sean Spence to stuff Adrian Peterson for a two-yard loss on the rush off left tackle in the second quarter.

- At Detroit (9/18), started at linebacker and led the team with 11 tackles before leaving the game early in the fourth quarter with an injury.
- Against Oakland (9/25), started at linebacker and led the team with 13 tackles with an interception and a quarterback pressure. Intercepted a Derek Carr pass that was deflected by Jason McCourty at the Tennessee 26-yard line in the fourth quarter.
- At Houston (10/2), started at linebacker and recorded a team-best 15 tackles, including a stop for loss. Teamed with Karl Klug to stuff Alfred Blue for no gain on a rush off left guard in the second quarter.
- Against Cleveland (10/16), started at linebacker and led the team with 10 tackles, including a sack and two quarterback pressures. Dropped Cody Kessler for a five-yard sack early in the fourth quarter.
- Against Indianapolis (10/23), started at linebacker and led the team with nine tackles. Combined with Jurrell Casey to stonewall Robert Turbin for no gain on a rush up the middle in the final stanza.
- Against Jacksonville (10/27), started at linebacker and tied for the team lead with eight tackles, including a sack and a quarterback pressure. Halted a Jaguars' drive by dropping Blake Bortles for a nine-yard sack on third-and-six late in the second quarter.
- At Indianapolis (11/20), started at inside linebacker and led the team with 10 tackles while adding a quarterback pressure. Combined with Wesley Woodyard to stop Frank Gore for no gain on a rush off right tackle late in the fourth quarter.
- Against Denver (12/11), started at inside linebacker and tied for the team lead with seven tackles, a stop for loss and a forced fumble. Stonewalled Devontae Booker for no gain on a third-and-one rush up the middle late in the first quarter. Sealed the win by forcing an A.J. Derby fumble that was recovered by Daimion Stafford with 53 seconds left to play in the fourth quarter.
- At Kansas City (12/18), started at inside linebacker and tallied seven tackles, including a stop for loss and a quarterback pressure. Got the Titans' offense the ball back late in the fourth quarter by stuffing Alex Smith for no gain on a third-and-two rush late in the fourth quarter.
- Against Houston (1/1), started at inside linebacker and led the team with 11 tackles, including two stops for loss and a quarterback pressure. Stuffed Jonathan Grimes for a two-yard loss on a rush up the middle early in the second quarter.

**2015 (15/15):** Started 15 games at inside linebacker and led the team with 137 tackles. Became the first player in the Titans era to start his career with back-to-back 100-tackle seasons. Ranked third on the squad with nine tackles for loss. Registered 3.5 sacks, 13 quarterback pressures and an interception. Was inactive for one contest. Led or tied for the team lead in tackles six times in 2015 (vs. IND, at NO, vs. CAR, vs. OAK, at NE at IND). Led or tied for the team lead in tackles for loss four times in 2015 (vs. CAR, at JAX, vs. OAK, vs. HOU). Led or tied for the team lead in sacks twice in 2015 (at JAX, vs. OAK). Tied for the team lead in quarterback pressures once in 2015 (vs. CAR). Registered a career-best 16 tackles against Carolina (11/15/15).

- Against Indianapolis (9/27), started at inside linebacker and led the team with a then career-high tying 12 tackles. Stuffed Frank Gore for no gain on a rush off right tackle in the first quarter.
- Against Buffalo (10/11), started at linebacker and finished second on the team with nine tackles, including a sack, a tackle for loss and a quarterback pressure. Dropped Tyrod Taylor for a 12-yard sack in the third quarter.
- Against Atlanta (10/25), started at inside linebacker and amassed five tackles and his first career interception. Teamed with Wesley Woodyard to stuff Devonta Freeman for no gain on a rush off left guard early in the fourth quarter. Intercepted a deflected Matt Ryan fourth-and-goal pass in the end zone late in the fourth quarter.
- At New Orleans (11/8), started at inside linebacker and tied for the team lead with 10 tackles, including two quarterback pressures. Teamed with Angelo Blackson to stuff Mark Ingram for a one-yard loss on a rush off right tackle in the final stanza. Stonewalled Ingram for no gain on a run off right guard in the fourth quarter.
- Against Carolina (11/15), started at inside linebacker and led the team with a career-high 16 tackles, including a half sack, three tackles for loss and two quarterback pressures. Stonewalled Jonathan Stewart for a one-yard loss on a rush off right end in the first quarter. Stuffed Stewart for a two-yard loss on a rush off left tackle in the third stanza. Combined with David Bass to drop Cam Newton for a nine-yard sack late in the third quarter.
- At Jacksonville (11/19), started at inside linebacker and collected five tackles, a sack, three tackles for loss and a quarterback pressure. Combined with Wesley Woodyard to stuff Denard Robinson for no gain on

a rush up the middle in the third quarter. Ended a Jaguars' drive by sacking Blake Bortles for a five-yard loss on third-and-nine in the fourth quarter. Stuffed T.J. Yeldon for no gain on a third-and-one carry up the middle late in the fourth quarter.

- Against Oakland (11/29), started at inside linebacker and led the team with 13 tackles, a sack, a stop for loss and a quarterback pressure. Dropped Derek Carr for a seven-yard sack in the first quarter.
- At New England (12/20), started at inside linebacker and led the team with 15 tackles. Combined with DaQuan Jones to stuff Brandon Bolden for no gain on a rush off right tackle in the final stanza.
- At Indianapolis (1/3), started at inside linebacker and led the team with 10 tackles with a quarterback pressure.

**2014 (16/12):** Appeared in 16 games with 12 starts at linebacker and ranked third on the team with 107 tackles in his rookie campaign. Tied for third on the squad with three sacks. Posted eight quarterback pressures, eight stops for loss, four passes defended and two fumble recoveries. Recorded seven special teams tackles on coverage units. Led or tied for the team lead in tackles three times in 2014 (vs. HOU, at BAL, vs. PIT). Led or tied for the team lead in sacks twice in 2014 (vs. HOU, vs. PIT). Tied for the team lead in passes defended twice in 2014 (vs. CLE, at HOU). Led or tied for the team lead in quarterback pressures three times in 2014 (at BAL, vs. PIT, at HOU). Registered his first career NFL start against Cleveland (10/5/14). Made his NFL debut at Kansas City (9/7/14).

- At Kansas City (9/7), made his NFL debut as a reserve on special teams.
- At Cincinnati (9/21), played as a reserve at linebacker and posted four tackles, including a stop for loss. Stonewalled Jeremy Hill for a two-yard loss on a rush off right guard in the second quarter.
- At Indianapolis (9/28), saw significant action as a reserve inside linebacker and finished second on the team with nine tackles.
- Against Cleveland (10/5), made his first career start at inside linebacker and finished second on the team with nine tackles and two passes defended. Halted a Browns' drive by breaking up a third-and-five pass intended for Jordan Cameron late in the second quarter. Broke up a pass intended for Cameron on third-and-three late in the third stanza.
- Against Jacksonville (10/12), started at inside linebacker and totaled seven tackles, including a stop for loss and a fumble recovery. Stopped Jordan Todman for no gain on a rush up the middle in the first stanza. Stuffed Todman for a one-yard loss on a rush off left end in the second quarter. Ended a potential Jaguars' scoring drive by recovering a Cecil Shorts III fumble that was forced by Jason McCourty at the Titans' eight-yard line in the fourth quarter.
- At Washington (10/19), started at inside linebacker and collected nine tackles and a fumble recovery. Recovered a Kirk Cousins fumble that was forced by a Derrick Morgan strip-sack in the first quarter.
- Against Houston (10/26), started at linebacker and led the team with 11 tackles, including a sack, two tackles for loss, a pass defended and a quarterback pressure. Stonewalled Arian Foster for a four-yard loss on a screen pass in the first quarter. Stopped Alfred Blue for no gain on a rush up the middle in the opening quarter. Registered his first career sack by dropping Ryan Fitzpatrick for a seven-yard loss in the second quarter. Knocked down a pass intended for Damaris Johnson in the second quarter.
- At Baltimore (11/9), started at linebacker and led the team with a career-best 12 tackles, including two stops for loss and two quarterback pressures. Stuffed Justin Forsett for a two-yard loss on a rush off left tackle in the second quarter. Stonewalled Steve Smith for no gain on a short pass early in the third quarter. Stopped Forsett for a three-yard loss on a rush off right end in the final stanza. Notched a special teams tackle on coverage units.
- Against Pittsburgh (11/17), started at linebacker and tied for the team lead with nine tackles, including a career-best two sacks, a team-high three quarterback pressures and a stop for loss. Teamed with Derrick Morgan to sack Ben Roethlisberger for a one-yard loss in the second quarter. Combined with Wesley Woodyard to sack Roethlisberger for an eight-yard loss in the third quarter. On the next play, ended a Steelers' drive by sacking Roethlisberger for an eight-yard loss on third-and-14. Collected a special teams tackle.
- At Houston (11/30), started at linebacker and notched six tackles, two quarterback pressures and a pass defended. Teamed with Derrick Morgan to stop Damaris Johnson for a seven-yard loss on a reverse in the fourth quarter. Batted down a pass intended for Foster in the fourth quarter.
- Against N.Y. Giants (12/7), started at linebacker and totaled eight tackles, including a stop for loss. Notched a special teams tackle. Teamed with Jurrell Casey to stonewall Andre Williams for a three-yard loss on a rush off left tackle in the second quarter. Stuffed Williams for no gain on a rush up the middle in the second stanza.

**COLLEGE:**

- In a four-year career at Kentucky, Williamson played in 49 games with 21 starts. He finished his career with 296 total tackles, including double-digit tackles in 12 career contests. After primarily serving on special teams in his first two years, he went over the 100-tackle mark as a junior (135) and senior (102).
- As a senior (2013), played in 12 games with 11 starts and finished the season as Kentucky's leading tackler for the second consecutive year, posting 102 total tackles to tie for fourth in the SEC. Additionally, he posted four tackles for loss, one sack, three quarterback hurries and two fumble recoveries. Served as captain in all 12 games. Had double-digit tackles in four games. Named All-SEC first team by CollegeSportsMadness.com. Earned All-SEC second-team honors from Associated Press, SEC Coaches, ESPN.com, Phil Steele's College Football and Athlon Sports. Also named to the SEC Community Service Team.
- As a junior (2012), registered 10 starts in 12 games and finished first on the team, second in the SEC and placed seventh nationally with 135 total tackles. Earned second-team All-SEC honors from CollegeSportsMadness.com and third-team All-SEC by Phil Steele's College Football. Had eight double-figure tackle performances. Recorded a streak of four games with at least 13 tackles in each game, the first UK player to do so since Randy Holleran in 1990. Additional contributions during the season included 4.5 tackles for loss, three sacks, an interception, four passes defended, two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery.
- As a sophomore (2011), played in all 12 games and registered 49 tackles, a tackle for loss, an interception, a pass defended and a forced fumble. Recorded at least two tackles in every game.
- As a freshman (2010), played in all 13 games, helping give the Wildcats depth at middle linebacker and totaled 10 tackles and one pass breakup.
- At the 2014 NFL Scouting Combine, he placed sixth among linebackers with a 4.66-second 40-yard dash and third among his position group with a 4.07-second short shuttle.

- Graduated in 2014 with a degree in integrated strategic communications.

**PERSONAL:**

- Attended Milan (Tenn.) High School, where he was a first-team Class AAA All-State linebacker as tabbed by the Tennessee Sports Writers Association. Led Milan to consecutive state championship finals with identical 14-1 records as a junior and senior. Named Region Defensive Player of the Year as a junior and senior. Named one of the top 15 players in Tennessee by Rivals.com.
- As a senior, named West Tennessee Player of the Year by the *Jackson Sun*. Made 125 tackles with one interception during the regular season in his senior year, and he also rushed for 416 yards and seven touchdowns at fullback.
- As a junior, collected 119 tackles, including 21 for loss. He set a Tennessee state championship game record with 22 tackles in the title contest.
- Was named the Outstanding Senior of his graduating high school class, recognizing academics, character and athletics. He was also a member of the honor-student club and the Spanish Club.
- At Kentucky, he was active in the community, participating in the Big Blue U Move-In (2011, 2012), the God's Pantry project (2012, 2013), Read Across America (2012, 2013), Salvation Army bellringing (2012), the "Be the Match" bone marrow drive (2012) and several school visits.
